Text: A success story

In 1945, Maurice Wilks was an engineer at Rover, the famous English car factory. He had an old Jeep from the American army. He loved his car and he used it in his free time for various jobs. One day, when his jeep was too older and unrepairable, his brother Spencer, the manager of Rover, asked him to design and make a light utility vehicle with Rover parts. Maurice then invented a four wheel drive car with a chassis inspired from his old Jeep and a light aluminium body. The first Land Rover appeared in April 1948 at the Amsterdam Car Show. Rover presented it as the farmer's ideal car. In 1949 the British army adopted it and used it in the old British colonies on the five continents. It was a great success, and the production of the original Land Rover only stopped in 1970. But we can still see legendary Land Rovers on the dusty roads of India, South Africa, Australia, Canada and New Zealand.
